(C) Tenure rights.

Neither the initial appointment nor any renewal, thereof, leads to the award of tenure.

(D) Rights and responsibilities.

A research faculty member is not a member of the CSU-AAUP collective bargaining unit until and, unless the faculty member completes six consecutive and complete academic years of service as a research faculty member.
